

SCHOLAR'S PASS APPLICATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. A Scholars Pass is not transferable.
2. A Scholars Pass does not provide any priority over any other passenger on any service or in a queue.
3. The Company does not accept liability for consequences arising from alteration in departure times or arrival times of any vehicle for the want of accommodation in any vehicle for the detention or delay in arrival at the destination or non arrival nor for any detention or delay in the arrival of a relief vehicle or the non supply of relief vehicles.
4. Scholars Passes must be shown to the driver on every journey and must be produced on demand to an authorised official.
5. The Company reserves the right to decline to issue or renew a Scholar's Pass. The Company also reserves the right to withdraw a pass for the purpose of identification should the scholar be seen to be committing a misdemeanour and should the need arise to refuse future travel should the incident be deemed serious. The Parent or Guardian will be held responsible for any cost arising through their child's misbehaviour while travelling on any of the Company's vehicles.
6. The loss of a Scholar's Pass must be reported immediately by phone and then in writing to the Company.
7. Lost, defaced, illegible or mutilated Scholars Passes must be replaced. A charge for a duplicate Scholar's Pass will be £10.00. Full payment with a written application must be sent to the Company. Only one duplicate ticket will be issued in any one term.
8. Scholar Passes are the property of the Company and must not be defaced, mutilated or made illegible. Passes must be returned immediately upon expiry.
9. Refund of a Scholar Pass or any unused or expired portions will be made at the Company's discretion.
10. All Scholars are requested to refrain from eating and/or drinking while on board the vehicle.
11. **SMOKING, ILLEGAL SUBSTANCES & ALCOHOL ARE PROHIBITED ON ALL VEHICLES.**
12. Seat belts must be worn at all times.
